LUGGAGE WHEELS

We have been made aware that the company issued luggage is difficult to pull/push, causing sprains/strains to cabin crew members. Please continue to submit Health & Safety Complaints as well as injury reports.

The company is aware of this problem, and while they have indicated that they would like to offer mitigations, no solution has been proposed yet.

Some cabin crew members have successfully changed the existing wheels to rollerblade/skate board wheels, and have indicated a significant change in how they feel using their luggage. This has not been officially company approved so please keep in mind that this may void your luggage warranty with Samsonite.
